

Sample Prolife Activity



FAMILY NIGHT DEVOTIONAL AND ACTIVITY:

READ: Psalm 139:1-18

QUESTIONS:

- How well does God know you? What verses tell you this?
- How involved has God been in your life? Did this interest in your life start when you were born? What did God do while you were still unborn?

- What does this tell you about the unborn?

READ: Psalm 72:12-14; Proverbs 31:8-9; Psalm 82:3-4; Proverbs 24:11-12

QUESTION:

- What can these verses tell us about our responsibility toward the unborn?
- Is there an excuse for doing nothing?

ACTIVITY:

Take pictures of your child(ren) doing various activities (reading books, playing games, riding bikes, dressing up, shooting baskets, etc.). Be creative and have fun as a family. You can make this as involved as you want—going to different places or just staying home.

If the pictures are digital, print two copies of each. If the pictures are on film, bring them to a one-hour photo developing service and get double prints. (You may want to go out for ice cream while you wait!)

Then rip up one set of pictures. When your children express their distress, focus them on what an offense it is to God when His works of creation are destroyed. (“If you are offended because your pictures were torn up, just think how much it offends God when His babies are destroyed.”)

Option: Send both sets of pictures to an abortion provider with a note. This can be a short, pithy note (e.g., “Aborted children never get to do this.” “Abortion prevents this.”), or even a note from your children (e.g., “Tonight our family...”). The tone should be truthful but not condemning. Pray that God would speak to the hearts of the clinic personnel.
